

TENNESSEE LEGISLATIVE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

For more than 50 years, the Tennessee Legislative Internship Program (TLIP) has provided students from across Tennessee the opportunity to experience Tennessee politics and contribute to the democratic process by serving as interns in the Tennessee General Assembly. Students completing the internship can receive up to 15 credit hours and a stipend of \$8,000 for the semester.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be registered to vote
- GPA: 3.0 GPA
- Enrolled as junior, senior, or graduate student; or completed at least 60 hours by Fall 2024

TIMELINE

- Application Deadline: 5pm on Fri, Sep 20
- Student Interviews: Mon, Sep 20 - Wed, Oct 2
Student Notifications: Wed, Oct 9
- TLIP Orientation: Mid Nov
- TLIP Reception: Late Nov/Early Dec General
- Assembly: Mon, Jan 13 - Fri, May 2
