

TENNESSEE LEGISLATIVE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

For more than 50 years, the Tennessee Legislative Internship Program (TLIP) has provided students from across Tennessee the opportunity to experience Tennessee politics and contribute to the democratic process by serving as interns in the Tennessee General Assembly. Students completing the internship can receive up to 15 credit hours and a stipend of \$8,000 for the semester.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be registered to vote
- GPA: 3.0 GPA
- Enrolled as junior, senior, or graduate student
- At least 20 years of age before January 12, 2026

TIMELINE

- Application Deadline: 12pm on Fri, Sept 26
- Student Interviews: Oct 1 and Oct 2
- Student Notifications: Fri, Oct 3
- TLIP Orientation: Mid Nov
- TLIP Reception: Late Nov/Early Dec
- General Assembly: Mon, Jan 12 - Fri, May 1
